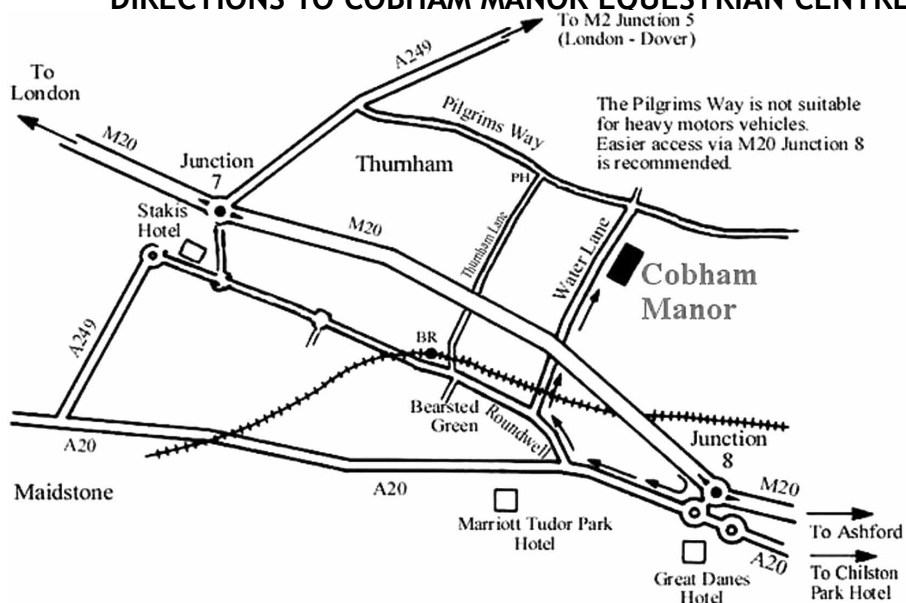

RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. Classes will be run under The Pony Club Eventing Rules 2010.
2. **ENTRIES MAY BE LIMITED.** Late entries £2 per class extra - if space available.
3. While every care will be taken the organisers hereby give notice that, to the extent permitted by law, they accept no responsibility for any injury, damage, loss or expense whatsoever or howsoever caused, arising out of or in any way connected with this competition.
4. The decision of the Judge is final.
5. Objections are to be made to the Secretary in writing, within 10 minutes of the conclusion of the class together with a deposit of £10, returnable if objection is sustained.
6. The Organisers accept no responsibility for any loss, damage or theft to any persons, animals or their belongings when on the show ground.
7. In the event of cancellation, £2 of the entry will be retained to defray costs. Refunds will be made upon receipt of a SAE within 7 days.
8. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel, amend or add to the classes as they see fit.
9. The Organisers reserve the right to alter times, split, amalgamate or cancel classes if found to be necessary.
10. When not competing all horses/ponies must be kept to the horsebox park or collecting rings. Horses/ponies tied to horseboxes or trailers must not be left unattended.
11. **Please clear up all droppings, hay and litter.**
12. No horse or pony may be ridden more than once in each class.
13. Pre-entered show entries will only be refunded on acceptance of a veterinary's or medical certificate within 7 days of the show. £1 per horse per class will be deducted for administration costs.
14. It is recommended that mares in season and all 'kickers' should wear a red ribbon on their tail.
15. There is a charge of £3.00 per competitor for the provision of First Aid Facilities.
16. All Competitors must have adequate and appropriate 3rd party liability cover.
17. All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
18. All mounted riders must wear hats conforming to the BSI standard for the activity and correctly tagged. They must be correctly fitted and chinstraps fastened where necessary.

The McGrath Cup is a magnificent challenge trophy donated to the West Street Branch of the Pony Club. They have generously allowed it to be used as a challenge trophy within Area 11.

Points for the Challenge Trophy which will be awarded at the end of the day as follows:

Individual

1st 10 points

2nd 8 points

3rd 6 points

4th 4 points

5th 2 points

6th 1 point

Teams

1st 40 points

2nd 30 points

3rd 20 points

4th 10 points

Teams will consist of 4 members with the best 3 scores to count.

Only the highest place team from each Pony Club can achieve team points for each class (this keeps the competition fair for those Pony Clubs unable to field several teams).

Two dressage classes will run concurrently commencing at 9.00 am prompt. Show jumping will be on grass, weather permitting.

Show-jumping: Approx 1'6"ft

Combination not to have been placed at Novice level

May be assisted but not led. Test may be called

Class 2: *Mini Teams and Individual*

Dressage Test: Introductory Dressage Test 2007

Show-jumping: Approx 2' - 2'3"ft

Class 3: *Novice Teams and Individual*

Dressage Test: Novice Eventing Test 2006

Show-jumping: Approx 2'6" - 2'9"ft

Class 4: *Intermediate Teams and Individual*

Dressage Test: Intermediate Eventing Test 2009

Show-jumping: Approx 3'ft

Class 5: *Open Teams and Individual*

Dressage Test: Open Eventing Test 2010

Show-jumping Approx 3'3" - 3'6"ft

Entry Fee: £17 for each class entered.

Late entries £2 per class if space available.

McGrath Cup awarded to best PC overall.

Rosettes to 6th place (Individual) and 4th place (Teams)

Challenge Trophy awarded to best WKM in each class.
