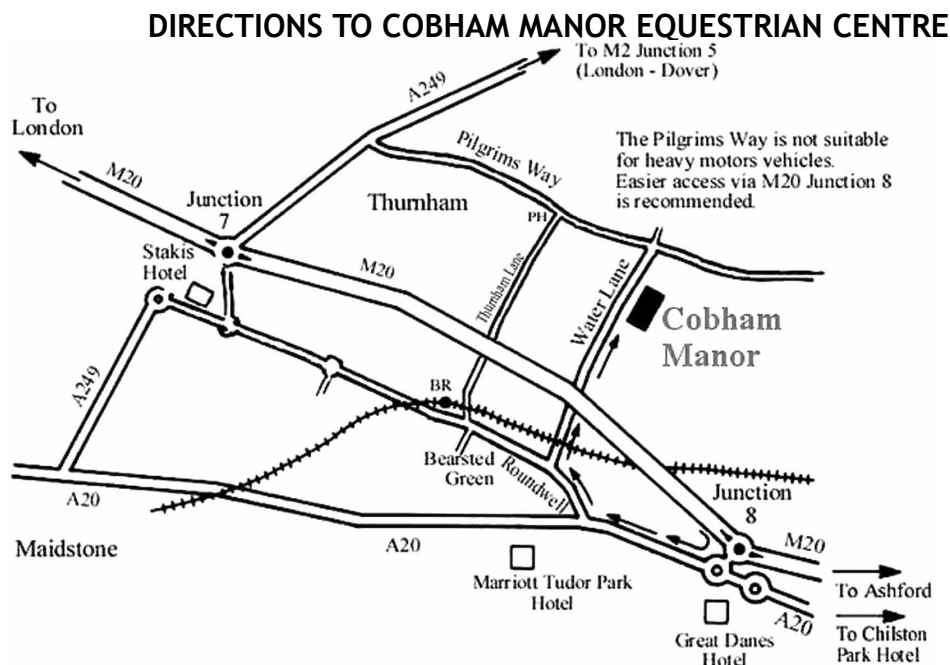


RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. Classes will be run under British Dressage Rules and in accordance with the 2010 Pony Club Dressage Rule Book and Dengie Dressage Rules 2009/2010.
2. Entries may be limited. Late entries £2 per class *extra if space available*.
3. While every care will be taken the organisers hereby give notice that, to the extent permitted by law, they accept no responsibility for any injury, damage, loss or expense whatsoever or howsoever caused, arising out of or in any way connected with this competition.
4. The decision of the Judge is final.
5. Objections are to be made to the Secretary in writing, within 10 minutes of the conclusion of the class together with a deposit of £10, returnable if objection is sustained.
6. The Organisers accept no responsibility for any loss, damage or theft to any persons, animals or their belongings when on the show ground.
7. In the event of cancellation, £2 of the entry will be retained to defray costs.
8. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel, amend or add to the classes as they see fit.
9. The Organisers reserve the right to alter times, split, amalgamate or cancel classes if found to be necessary.
10. When not competing all horses/ponies must be kept to the horsebox park or collecting rings. Horses/ponies tied to horseboxes or trailers must not be left unattended.
11. Please clear up all droppings, hay and litter.
12. No horse or pony may be ridden more than once in each class.
13. Pre-entered show entries will only be refunded on acceptance of a veterinary's or medical certificate within 7 days of the show. £1 per horse per class will be deducted for administration costs.
14. It is recommended that mares in season and all 'kickers' should wear a red ribbon on their tail.
15. There is a charge of £2.00 per competitor for the provision of First Aid Facilities.
16. All Competitors must have adequate and appropriate 3rd party liability cover.
17. All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
18. All mounted riders must wear hats conforming to the BSI standard for the activity. they must be correctly fitted and chinstraps fastened where necessary.

ELIGIBILITY for Pony Club **Dengie Winter League Dressage Novice - Open to non-members**, members of the Pony Club and Centre members, but excluding any combination of horse/pony and rider that have represented their Branch at Open Area qualifiers for The Pony Club Dressage Championships or any Rider who has competed at The Pony Club Open Open to all Members of The Pony Club, including Associates. Centre Members are invited to compete in this competition. Dressage Championships. (This does not include any other classes held in conjunction with Area Qualifiers). **Riders** must not have won any BD (or DI) points or competed at BD (or DI) Elementary level or above. **Horses** may be graded British Dressage Novice or below.

ELIGIBILITY for Pony Club **Dengie Winter League Dressage Open - Open to non-members** and members of the Pony Club including Associates and Centre members. **Horses** which have competed at Advanced Medium level or above during the current year are not eligible. This includes Hors Concours entries.

A member may qualify in any Area but must go to their own Area Competition. The first 4 will qualify for one of the 19 Area Competitions and qualifications can pass down the line. If a class is split then 2 from each section will qualify.

Non-members of The Pony Club are allowed to compete in any preliminary round but must become fully paid up members to compete at their Area Competition.
